



RESPECTFUL AND FAIR TREATMENT OF STUDENTS POLICY

HOLLYWOOD NORTH SOUND INSTITUTE

1. Purpose

Hollywood North Sound Institute is committed to fostering a respectful, inclusive, and fair learning environment for all students. This policy ensures that students are treated with dignity and fairness in all interactions with faculty, staff, and peers.

2. Commitment to Respect and Fairness

Hollywood North Sound Institute upholds the following principles:

- Every student has the right to be treated with respect and without discrimination or harassment.
- All students will be provided equal opportunities to participate in educational programs and activities.
- Faculty and staff will communicate with students in a professional and respectful manner.
- Institutional policies, including those related to grading, discipline, and attendance, will be applied fairly and consistently.

3. Student Rights and Responsibilities

Students Have the Right To:

- Learn in a safe and respectful environment.
- Be free from harassment, discrimination, or intimidation.
- Receive fair and consistent evaluation of their academic performance.
- Express their opinions in a respectful manner.



Students Are Responsible For:

- Treating peers, instructors, and staff with respect.
- Following institutional policies and codes of conduct.
- Engaging in open and constructive communication when resolving conflicts.

4. Addressing Concerns

- If a student feels they have been treated unfairly or disrespected, they are encouraged to address the concern directly with the individual involved.
- If the issue is not resolved, the student may submit a formal complaint in writing to the Director of Student Affairs, following the institution's Dispute Resolution Policy.
- Hollywood North Sound Institute strictly prohibits retaliation against any student who raises a concern in good faith.

5. Policy Acknowledgment

- This policy is provided to students before the start of their program.
- Students must acknowledge receipt and understanding of this policy by signing a copy upon enrollment.
